LISA MORRISON JOINS EDUF AS VP OF RESEARCH & DEVELOPMENT



How God Led Lisa Morrison to EDUF

In my late twenties, God planted a vision in my heart to teach overseas in one of our Nazarene colleges. Whenever I would *see* this vision, I saw black people. I tried a few times to make the vision a reality, but my efforts always came to nothing.

In 2013, I was presented with the opportunity to go to Africa on a mission trip. I had no interest, but my way was being paid, and my niece was going to join me. We went to South Africa in 2014. On the way home, I thought to myself, "I will never make this trip again!" In less than a year's time, I found myself back in South Africa at Nazarene

Theological College as a Guest Lecturer for a semester. Everything I had seen in my vision from twenty years ago was being lived out on campus. Never in my wildest imagination could I have foreseen what God had in store for me.

At the end of my semester. God woke me up at dawn one morning and said, "Thapi (one of my students) was the daughter I had always wanted." I had no idea what that meant but over time God revealed to Thapi and me that he wanted her to come to America to get her bachelor's and master's degrees in theology. He asked me if I was willing to lay my life down to support, love and mentor her through the 5-year process.

A passion for helping African ministers acquire their theological education was birthed in me during our journey. When I discovered what EDUF was doing to make this passion a reality, it was all too easy to say yes to Margaret Scott when she asked me to come on board as Vice President of Research and Development.

My work at EDUF is a dream job of seeing a way made for African clergy to receive their education whether in the US or in Africa. As Nelson Mandela stated:

Education is the most powerful weapon you can use to change the world.

May we not only change the world with educated leaders, but may we also build God's Church by providing her with an educated clergy.

Since 2016, Africa has the most Nazarene members worldwide, yet the statistics from 2021 reflect we have only 1716 ordained ministers for the 8599 African Nazarene churches. In stark contrast, the US/Canada has 11,577 ordained clergy for the 5274 Nazarene churches. Africa needs our help, and this is what EDUF is seeking to do.

I am excited God has led me to be a part of making a difference as I work with
