

EDUF Election Results

At the Annual Membership Meeting of EDUF held on Zoom on October 17, ballots were cast remotely and during the gathering. EDUF OFFICERS. The trustees then elected board chair, Randall Craker, board vice-chair, Randall James, and Secretary, Sharon Bull. Because of the passing of the esteemed district superintendent of Washington Pacific district, Rev. Jerry Kester, an interim superintendent was designated - EDUF board chair, Randall Craker. So, EDUF trustees elected Randall James to be interim chair and Carol Rotz to be interim vice chair. Other EDUF officers, treasurer, office manager and president are elected by the board.

Change in TNU Scholarships

At the Annual Membership Meeting, the board also voted to modify the criteria for the EDUF endowed scholarship at TNU. This change has already been implemented at the university. It now reads: The scholarship will be awarded to a student from Africa who

- is enrolled in any degree program (undergraduate, graduate, or postgraduate) and
- will communicate each term with the donors, Education Development United Fellowship, by email Admin@eduf.org.

This modification enlarges the pool of students eligible to apply.
